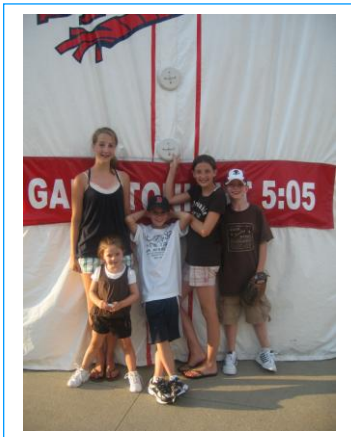
you see on site. Please save the date and stop by to see all they have to offer or place your order for a picnic table or chairs.
